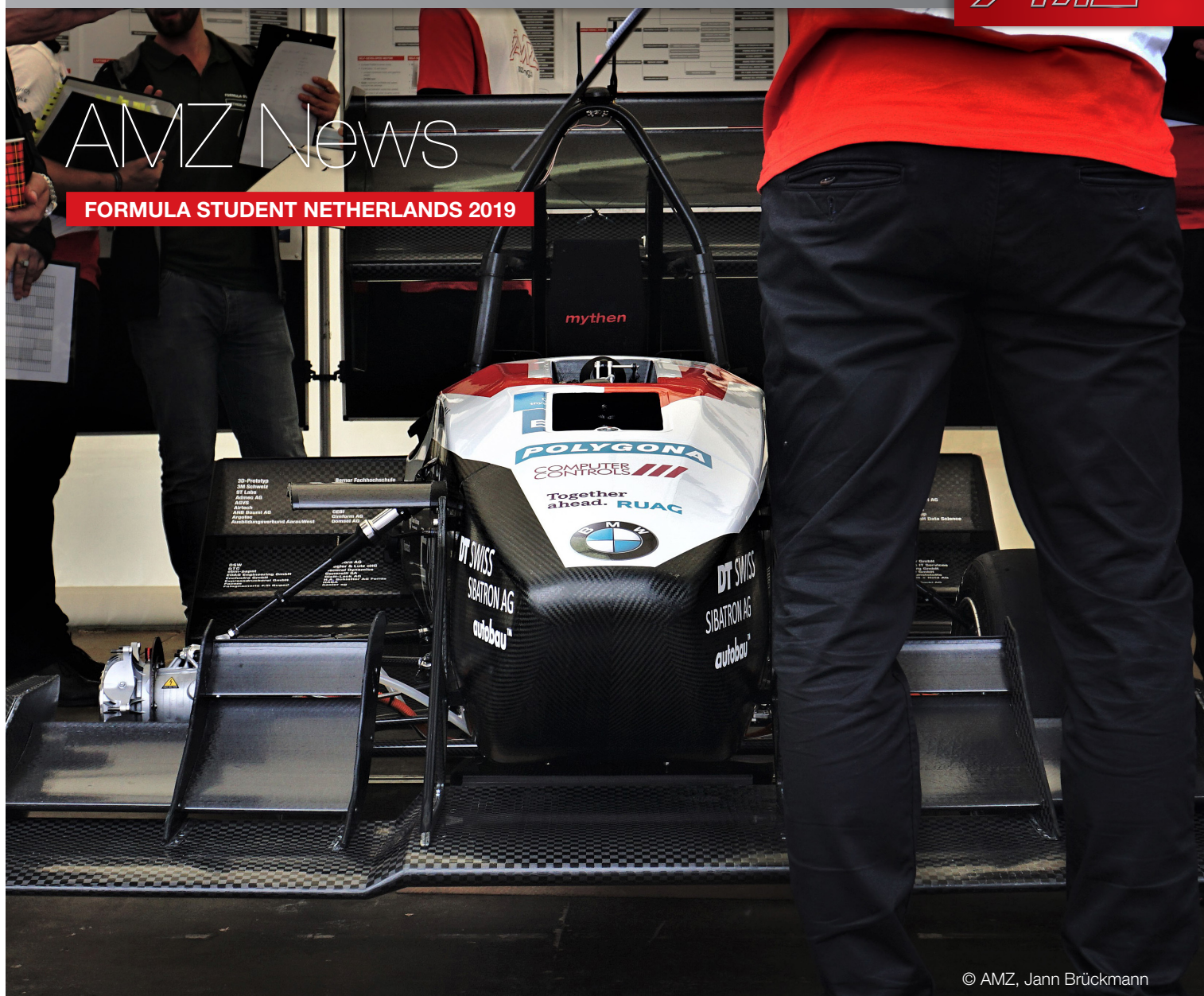

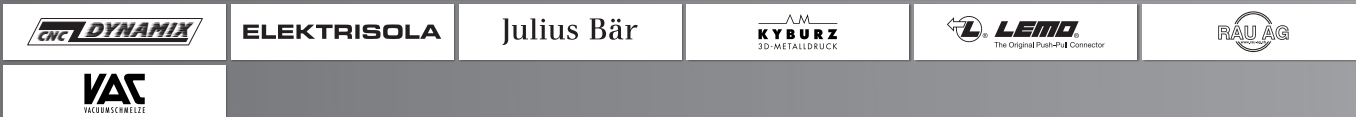

Op naar Nederland

After months of preparation, planning and an intensive test season it was finally about time. On Saturday, the 6th of July, the whole team gathered in the workshop in the evening to get ready for the long journey to Formula Student Netherlands. The cars were ready, the tanks were filled, the batteries were charged and each part and tool was carefully stowed in boxes, numbered and accounted for.

In order to reach TT Circuit Assen as quickly and as possible and without hitting any traffic jams, we decided to drive straight through the night - and half an hour before midnight, the last car had finally left the workshop.

A packed schedule

Immediately after our arrival, the event program started and we got ready for the coming week - the campsite was built, the pit was set up. Every box had its place, and the car was ready for

the technical inspections. These were next up on the list, and while battery and electrical scrutineering could already be passed on Monday, mechanical scrutineering was then completed on Tuesday after minor teething problems.

Statics

Undeterred by minor rain showers, we were able to demonstrate our technical expertise, presentation skills and cost understanding in parallel to scrutineering on Monday and Tuesday for the first time this season. Apparently we were performing well enough, and the judges placed us in the finals for all three static disciplines. In the end, we achieved a second place in both engineering design and cost and manufacturing, of which we are incredibly proud.

Dynamics

After three cold and rainy days in the Netherlands, it was then time to heat up

the track. Despite technical difficulties, mythen ran its skidpad, acceleration and autocross events without any larger hiccups. But then, problems arose for us again on the next day, when an unlucky combination of a rain shower and high voltage electronics meant a DNF for us on the fourth lap of the endurance race.

Outlook

Despite many issues and not quite the results we had hoped for, we return from the Netherlands with many positive experiences and a sixth place in the overall rankings. We recognize that we still have a long way to go before our next event in Spielberg, and the team is working tirelessly to improve every day.

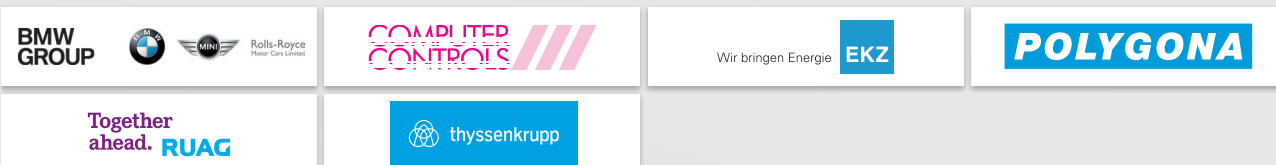
